In order to implement this regulation, there will be a need to make changes to the traffic management in the surrounding streets and roads and introduce car parking charges on the estate.

We are seeking residents' views on what needs to be addressed as a result of this proposed new regulation.

This regulation will also potentially allow the implementation of parking charges to the main car park and all overflow parking areas, these charges are proposed to be set at £2 for all day.




### Traffic order key
