

Halsbury Road & Cairns Road – Pedestrian Improvements

Public Consultation Report

Summary of results

The public consultation took place in July 2015 to which 9 responses were received. All generally supported the scheme but some issues were raised about loss of parking, the positioning and size of the proposed tree pit and the island.

The responses have now been reviewed and the comments used to finalise a design for the pedestrian improvements on Halsbury Road/Cairns Road. The kerb alignment has been altered to make it easier for large vehicles to turn and bollards have been added to highlight the crossing point. It was not possible to alter the position of the island without affecting access to the neighbouring property and impacting on the pedestrian route and parking.

The detailed design is now being finalised and preparations made to commence construction.
