As part of 'Safer Routes to School', Bristol City Council has made a commitment to making the Zig-Zags outside schools in Bristol mandatory.



Once they are mandatory then no vehicles will be able to stop on them Monday to Friday between the hours of 8am and 6pm to coincide with Children and Young People's Services Extended School Guidelines. They will also be consistent with other schools across Bristol.



Elmlea Infant and Junior Schools are part of the second batch of schools to go through this process. The Zig-Zags will be of specific legally enforceable lengths with accompanying signage. Their location has been drawn up with the help of the schools. For the most part they have been kept close to the existing layout.
