# Canford Lane

# Pedestrian Crossing



October 2021

Funding has been allocated by local area committee to provide a safe pedestrian crossing point of Canford Lane. The current proposal is for a new zebra crossing of Canford Lane just to the east of the main entrance to Canford Crematorium and Cemetery. There is no current existing crossing facility in this area, the nearest being at the junction of Canford Lane and Falcondale Road.

It is important to note that we are currently awaiting the results of a traffic speed survey that will determine the suitability and safety of this location for a zebra crossing and that the proposed location and crossing type may change based on this information.

The proposed zebra crossing incorporates a footway buildout on both sides of the road. The buildouts are proposed to improve visibility between pedestrians and other road users. The road narrowing should also have the additional benefit of controlling speeds of vehicles passing the crossing. The crossing will include flush kerbs with tactile paving, road markings and flashing Belisha beacons.

As part of the design we will also review street lighting and road surface condition in the vicinity of the crossing point.

Bristol City Council is seeking the public's view on this proposed crossing to understand any benefits or disadvantages for local residents.
