**RE: Canford Lane Pedestrian Crossing**

Funding has been allocated by local area committee to provide a safe pedestrian crossing point of Canford Lane.

Bristol City Council would like to invite you to comment on the design we are proposing to deliver with this funding.

The current proposal is for a new zebra crossing of Canford Lane just to the east of the main entrance to Canford Crematorium and Cemetery. This design includes pedestrian footway buildouts on each side that will reduce the road width at the crossing point and should improve safety by controlling vehicle speeds and improving visibility between pedestrians and other road users.

It is important to note that we are currently awaiting the results of a traffic speed survey that will determine the suitability and safety of this location for a zebra crossing and that the proposed location and crossing type may change based on this information.
