RE: Hillside Road Traffic Calming

Funding has been allocated by local area committee to install traffic calming on Hillside Road with the aim of reducing vehicle speeds and improving safety for all.

Bristol City Council would like to invite you to comment on the design proposal for the use of this funding.

The design focuses on installing speed cushions at key locations along Hillside Road and Kingsway Avenue with a raised pedestrian crossing (or speed table) for Air Balloon Hill Primary School.

There are also proposals for pedestrian and safety improvements at two junctions on Hillside Road. These junctions are at the A431 (Air Balloon Road) and Batten Road.
