

Parks Byelaws

further consultation



The council is continuing with the process of adopting a new set of parks byelaws for Bristol, to tackle nuisance behaviour and support safe enjoyment for all.

Consultation in 2013 showed support for byelaws. The number of byelaws has been reduced from 29 to 24 following feedback during the consultation.

This consultation primarily focuses on what areas should be designated for 4 activities: flying of model aircraft, horse-riding, fishing and having a BBQ.

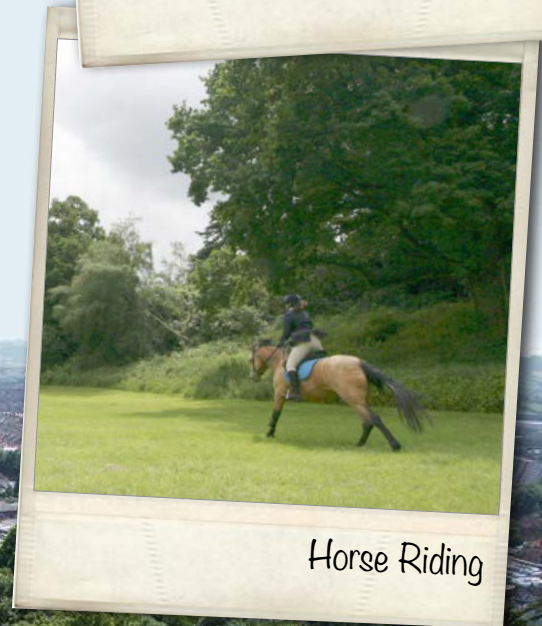
