Merchants' Academy – Bishport Avenue Crossing

As part of the 'Safer Routes to School Scheme', proposals are being made for improvements to the crossing point on Bishport Avenue at Withywood Road junction on a pedestrian route to Merchants' Academy Primary School. This is the location where a School Crossing Patrol operates and assists children, parents and other members of the public to cross the road safely.

The proposals being made (shown on the enclosed plan) are for improved crossing points with dropped kerbs and tactile paving. Also proposed are pencil type bollards which will help to prevent parking on the footway and highlight the close vicinity of the school.
