

THE CITY AND COUNTY OF BRISTOL (BRIDGE STREET) (PROHIBITION OF ENTRY TO BALDWIN STREET AND HIGH STREET) ORDER, 1965.

The Council of the City and County of Bristol in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 26 and subsection (4) of Section 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order:

- 1. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle so that it shall enter the roads specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order from the road specified in the second column of the said Schedule.
2. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the Twenty-First day of November 1965 and may be cited as "The City and County of Bristol (Bridge Street) (Prohibition of Entry to Baldwin Street and High Street) Order, 1965."
